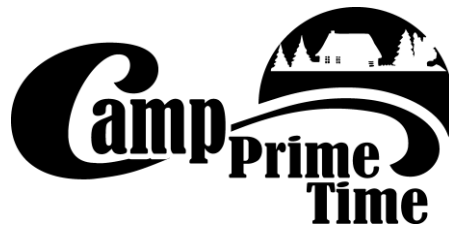


Camp Season, 2019

Refundable Deposit

A registration deposit check for **\$25.00** per family should be made out to "Prime Time, Inc." and given to your contact person by more than a month before your camping weekend. This check will be deposited at the time the camp receives it. You will have the option on the Saturday morning you are at camp to request the deposit be returned to you or consider donating it to Prime Time.

Google Maps displays the camp's location with a search "810 NF-744, Naches, WA." This search does not traditionally work in most GPS modules. Please use directions posted on the website.

Special Notes

In order to provide for the safety and well being of all campers, Camp Prime Time requests the following:

- **READ THE CAMP'S INFORMATION BROCHURE!!!!**
- **NO PETS ALLOWED.** We understand that often your pet is part of your family, but due to problems in the past we cannot have pets at camp.
- **Fill up your gas tank** before reaching camp. The closest gas stations are at the summit of White Pass or in Naches.
- **Bikes are discouraged**, but if you choose to bring one, please remember all safety equipment. The closest medical care is about one hour away.
- **Dietary Needs** - Let your group leader know if someone in your family has a special dietary need that the Volunteers will need to know about.
- **Check out time is Noon on the final day at camp.** Please clean your cabin before departure and respect the check-out time. If you need some additional time, please speak with the camp volunteers.
- **Parking Fee** - The forest service charges at least \$5 for parking in most places outside of our facility. Our families will be able to obtain a **FREE Inter-Agency Access** pass through the forest service at any Ranger's Station. Please reference their website at <https://www.fs.fed.us/visit/passes-permits/recreation-fees-passes> for their required documents. If you plan to use your car to park down at the boat dock, please obtain the Access Pass prior to arrival.
- **Personal First-Aid** - We recommend bringing a first-aid kit. The camp does have some supplies for treating minor injuries, which can be obtained through the volunteers in the back of the kitchen.
- **Cancellation:** If you need to cancel, please let your group leader know immediately so they can find another family to enjoy the camping weekend.
